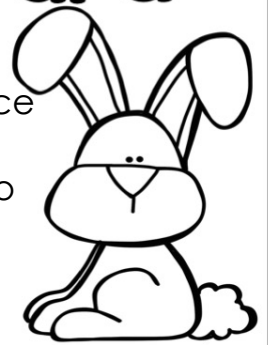


April Homework Choice Board
