In May of each year, the Beaver Area Education Association awards a scholarship of \$1,500 to a graduating senior who plans to major in education and pursue a career in teaching. Half of the scholarship is awarded at the Senior Awards Ceremony and the remaining half will be awarded at the beginning of the awardee's senior year of college (after college transcript verification). To be eligible for the scholarship the following qualifications must be met:

- To major in education or an education related field
- To be enrolled in the Beaver Area School District
- To be judged on academic excellence, extra-curricular activities, work experience, volunteer experience, and teaching experience
- To have letter of application/essay completed which expresses the student's interest in education and states his/her career goals
- To have two teacher recommendation letters

After submitting an application, the BAEA Scholarship Committee, composed of elementary, middle and high school teachers, will evaluate all applications and an awardee will be selected.
