E.M. NESBITT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The E.M. Nesbitt Memorial Fund is a fund established by the family of the late former pastor of Park Presbyterian Church, Dr. E. Marcellus Nesbitt. The Fund is a memorial to Dr. Nesbitt and provides scholarships to needy high school seniors who will be continuing their education. Dr. Nesbitt served Park Church from 1941-1966 and it was there that he and his wife, Helen, raised their three children, sons Hugh and John, and daughter, Gail.

In 1992, the Nesbitt family gave an initial gift to the Presbyterian Church (USA) Foundation, who will administer the Fund. The Nesbitt family will continue to support the Fund. Contributions to the Fund by others are not solicited but will be accepted from those who wish to memorialize Dr. Nesbitt or others.

A Scholarship Committee, consisting of the Pastor and three members of Park Presbyterian Church will determine the recipients. The members of the Scholarship Committee will be approved by the Session and will serve indefinite terms.

ELIGIBILITY

The main criterion for the award is a need for financial assistance. Applicants must demonstrate a good work ethic both in and out of the classroom. Decisions will also be weighted for students pursuing a career in the ministry or other church vocation. Applicants must complete and submit an application, a transcript, and two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from one of the applicant's high school teachers, by **April 16**. Each applicant may be required to meet individually with the Scholarship Committee.

AWARDS

A total award of \$1500 will be made by the Scholarship Committee. Announcement of the successful applicant will be made by June 1, and the award will be presented by a representative of the Nesbitt family in a Sunday worship service at Park Presbyterian Church. The check will be drawn jointly in favor of the recipient and the institution which the recipient will attend.
