Reading: Read for a minimum of 15 minutes each day (book or digital source). Practice sequencing the main events from the stories. Use words like beginning , middle , and end .					
Sight Words: Monday - Sight word Pyramid: Ex: t th the Tuesday - Tactile print your words in/on something other than paper or pencil. (flour, sugar, rice, etc.) Wednesday - Sight word rubbings: you will need to use a hot glue gun or elmers glue and write the words in glue and let them dry. Once dry, place a piece of paper over the words you have written in glue and use a crayon to begin rubbing and then before your eyes words will appear! If you don't have these materials write your words using a pattern of different colors Thursday - Sing your sight words to the tune of BINGO. Ex. There was a sight word of the day and "do" was our sight word!

 Math: Determine if an object is heavier than or lighter than another object. 1. Watch the lesson video (**Disclaimer- these videos are found on YouTube so please monitor your child at this time) 2. Practice the skill the lesson video covered, using the suggested questions and objects if you have them available.

Thursday - Hold your shoe in one hand and an adult's shoe in your other hand. Whose shoe is heavier ? Whose shoe is lighter ? Friday - Tell an adult 3 things that would be too heavy for you to carry in your backpack. Now tell an adult 3 things that would be light enough to carry in your backpack.			
Practice counting <u>backwards</u> from 100. Challenge yourself and start at any number between 100 and 1.			
Writing: Write the sentence for today. Remind your child to use a capital letter at the beginning and punctuation at the end.
