Wednesday - I can tell about unknown addends (the numbers you add together or the 2 <u>parts</u>) if I know the total amount. Thursday - I can use objects and drawings to show less than.</p>					

<p>Friday - I can take from a whole amount and write a number sentence with a minus sign.</p>
