## Race and Roll Subtraction

Number of Players: 2 or more

Materials Needed: at least 1 six-sided game die or up to one

dice per player

## Directions:

All players start at 20. Players take turns rolling a die, saying a number sentence, and subtracting the number rolled from their number.

For example, Player A rolls 6 and says, "20 - 6 = 14," then Player B rolls 3 and says, "20 - 3 = 17." They continue taking turns and saying number sentences until they get down to zero. It must be an exact zero! For example, if the player is at 3 and roll 5, they lose that turn and continue playing until they hit zero!

Winning the Game: The player to reach zero first wins the game!

Alternate Game Play Options:

- -Start with a higher number than 20; you choose what you think you can manage!
- -Start at 0 and count up to 20 or a number of your choice by stating addition number sentences.
- -Play as addition or subtraction but count but 10, 5, or 2's instead.
