

Chapter 1 - Lesson 2 Vocabulary

vertebrate - animal with a backbone

mammal - an animal that has hair and produces milk for its young

reptile - an animal that has dry scaly skin

amphibian - an animal that has moist skin and no scales (it's born in the water and raised on the land, lays eggs in a jelly-like mass, it has no covering on its skin, it's an amphibian)

invertebrate - an animal without a backbone

arthropod - an invertebrate with legs that have several joints

mollusk - an invertebrate that may or may not have a hard outer shell
