instinct - a behavior that an animal begins life with; it's an adaptation to help an animal meet its needs

migration - the movement of a group of one type of animal from one region to another and back again

hibernation - a period of time when an animal goes into a long, deep sleep

learned behavior - an activity that a creature is not born knowing how to do; an example would be a tiger cub learning how to hunt by watching its mother
